Where is it this year?

Burnaby Fraser Foreshore Park

This year, the Rivers Day celebration is in Burnaby Fraser Foreshore Park at the south end of Byrne Road in the Big Bend neighbourhood. It's where Byrne Creek flows into the Fraser River. (see map)

How do I get there?

Take transit, carpool or ride your bike!

Take the #116 bus from either Metrotown or Edmonds Skytrain station and disembark at Byrne Road and North Fraser Way. It's a short walk to the event site. Or ride your bike – the event is located near the Glenlyon Parkway urban trail. Free, secure bicycle parking will be available courtesy of BEST (Better Environmentally Sound Transportation). Or you can car-pool! Visit the Jack Bell Ride-Share program website at www.ride-share.com to find your ride-match. Limited vehicle parking, including on-street parking, is also available and located nearby.
