Gardeners Be Aware... Invasive Plants In Your Garden!

Invasive plants are plants that fill your garden quickly. They take over gardens, spreading beyond the intended planting area, covering entire beds and crowding out desirable plants. These plants are persistent and endure years of repeated pulling and often chemical treatment to permanently remove them. Common invasive species include Common English Ivy, Lamium, Common Periwinkle and Bishop's Weed.
